Medium enterprises followed with a share of 10.3% while micro enterprises registered a share of 4.9%. Among small enterprises, wholesale and retail trade and repair contributed the most with a share of 4.07% followed by manufacturing with a share of 3.82% while financial intermediation was next with a share of 3.35%.

Loans lent to SMEs All lending institutions are required to lendset aside at least 6% of their total loan portfolioto small enterprises and at least 2% to medium-sized enterprises. The Republic Act 6977 enacted in 1991 (theMagna Carta for Small Enterprises) required10% more to be diverted to SME's.
